

L.I.N.K. Information



What: LINK is an afterschool, supervised study hall that is available to students who need extra time for homework.

When: LINK is generally held every Tuesday and Thursday afternoon from 2:35 – 4:00.

Where: The LMC

Other Information:

- Students are to report promptly to the LMC right after school
- Students will sign in at the LINK binder upon arrival
- Students should bring all the materials they will need, along with anything that they are bringing home after LINK
- Students are required to stay for the entire time – until 4:00 (they are not allowed to come and go throughout LINK)
- Students should sit one per table
- Students may use the LMC computers ONLY for school work or to work on a math log
- LINK is a silent work time for students
- Cell phones are to remain off and put away during LINK, just like during the school day
- Students may use personal listening devices as long as they continue to work
 - Exception: if that means a cell phone for a student, he or she may use it as long as it is ONLY used for listening to music
- Two teachers are available to help provide support for students in completing their work
- Students arriving late to LINK must have a pass from a teacher
